New Bank: A strong recommendation is being made to change banks. Umpqua Bank has been somewhat difficult/laborious to deal with this past year. Lisa feels that we could find someone that would maybe have a more stream-lined and user-friendly process. Lisa motions to close the account at Umpqua and transfer our funds to another local bank - to be determined. Nicole seconds. All vote in favor - passes.

Volunteer positions still to be filled: We discussed possibilities for staffing the year book position - maybe even paying someone. Spirit Wear- Mitzi is going to limit to t-shirts and

hoodies - will take care of that at the beginning of the year. Also discussed having staff appreciation lunches catered with some of our overage.
